Please join us for the 8th Annual Bear Cupboard Run Saturday morning, July 15th, on the scenic Bearskin Trail! This is Lakeland Pantry's largest fundraiser of the year with all proceeds going to the pantry and Wisconsin Nordic Development Group (WNDG).

Your participation in the BCR will provide you the opportunity to run one of the most beautiful trails in the Northwoods while helping to support two great causes benefiting thousands of men, women, and youth.

Lakeland Pantry, a 501(c) 3, has more than 2,400 families registered with 5,000+ people served monthly; children comprise 40% of this number. Sixteen thousand pounds of food are distributed weekly. Clothing and books are also distributed.

WNDG, a 501(c) 3, promotes & financially supports Nordic ski programs for youth in Wisconsin elementary, middle, and high schools. This group runs the Nordic state championship where 36+ schools participate, and several Wisconsin summer ski camps, provides coach certification scholarships, & donates skis where needed.

Half Marathon Details

- **Must maintain a 15 min. mile pace; course closes at 10:30 am**
- **Runners must be 12 years of age or older**
- **No Race Switches**
- **6:15-6:30 am:** Shuttle buses leave from Flambeau Street at American Legion
- **7:30 am: Race starts ~ Chip timed**
- Start is ½ mile from X of Bearskin Trail & Lakewood Rd. at Goodnow, 12 mi. S. of Minocqua. See trifold map (website/on-site)
- Port-a-potties at trailhead
- Restrooms at halfway point near Blue Lake Rd.
- Trail is packed crushed granite
- Minimal elevation changes
- All miles are clearly marked
- Eight water/snack stations along the 13.1 mile run
- Spectator viewing area at X near Jacobi's Restaurant & at S. Blue Lake Rd.
- Ambulance/aid station at finish
- Food/refreshments at finish, Torpy Park
- Pre & post race massages available
- First year racers completing run receive a participation medal or a "2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th year participation pin"
- Ages: 12-18; 19-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70-74; 75+
- Awards presented at 10 am

5K Run Details

- **8:00 am:** Race starts ~ Chip Timed
- Start at Torpy Park on to Bearskin Trail
- Out and back 2.5K
- 2 water/energy snack stations on trail
- Food/refreshments at finish, Torpy Park
- 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74; 75+
- Awards presented at 9 am

5K Walk Details

- **8:05 am:** Chip timed
- Walkers go out and back 2.5K
- Bearskin Trail is a public trail, but for safety, we recommend that you please refrain from having pets or strollers on trail during race
- Awards presented at 9 am

Cubby Run Details

- **7:45 am:** Race starts at Torpy Park
- Must be 9 years and under
- Out & back 1.6K run on the Bearskin Trail
- Benji the bear & teen Cubs will be on trail
- All Cubbies receive a t-shirt, pack & bear paw pin
- **Register by July 1st to guarantee t-shirt**

Inclement Weather Policy

- Races will be held rain or shine
- Cancellation of race/races will be at discretion of race directors. Local weather authorities & reports will be consulted
- Safety of runners is of prime importance
- **Registration fees are non-refundable**
